<b>Details of the violation(s)/contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed</b>	Order 1 has been passed by GST Authority on the contention that the Company during FY 2019-20 has claimed inadmissible and ineligible Input Tax Credit (ITC).  The GST Authority has ordered for recovery of the same along with applicable interest and penalty.	Order 2 has been passed by GST Authority on the contention that the Company during FY 2019-20 has incorrectly reported liability in Form GSTR-3B vis-à-vis in the E-Way Bills.  The GST Authority has ordered for recovery of the same along with applicable interest and penalty.
<b>Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible.</b>	Based on assessment of facts and prevailing law, the Company is of the view that the penalty levied is arbitrary and unjustified. The Company will file necessary appeal with the appellate authority in this regard.  There is no material impact on the Company’s financials or operations due to the said order.
