Sparking curiosity for science among 3500+ students in Sikkim through Mobile Science Lab

Sikkim, December 2, 2019: Further strengthening its purpose to support quality education to every child, Cipla Foundation, the social responsibility arm of Cipla Ltd, launches the second Mobile Science Lab (MSL) with its implementing partner, Agastya International Foundation. This innovative project revolutionizes rural education and makes hands-on learning increasingly accessible. It is a fun, engaging and interactive channel that aims to raise awareness on science among children and teachers from government & government-aided schools, through classroom sessions, science fairs and community visits.

The second Mobile Science Lab was launched by the Additional Chief Secretary – Government of Sikkim, Mr. G P Upadhyaya, on 2nd December 2019 at Govt. Senior Secondary School Rhenock (E). The event was attended by local PRI members, Army Officials, Principals of Govt. Schools and students. The newly launched Mobile Science Lab will reach out to 1400 students across 10 schools in the periphery of Golden Cross Unit.
