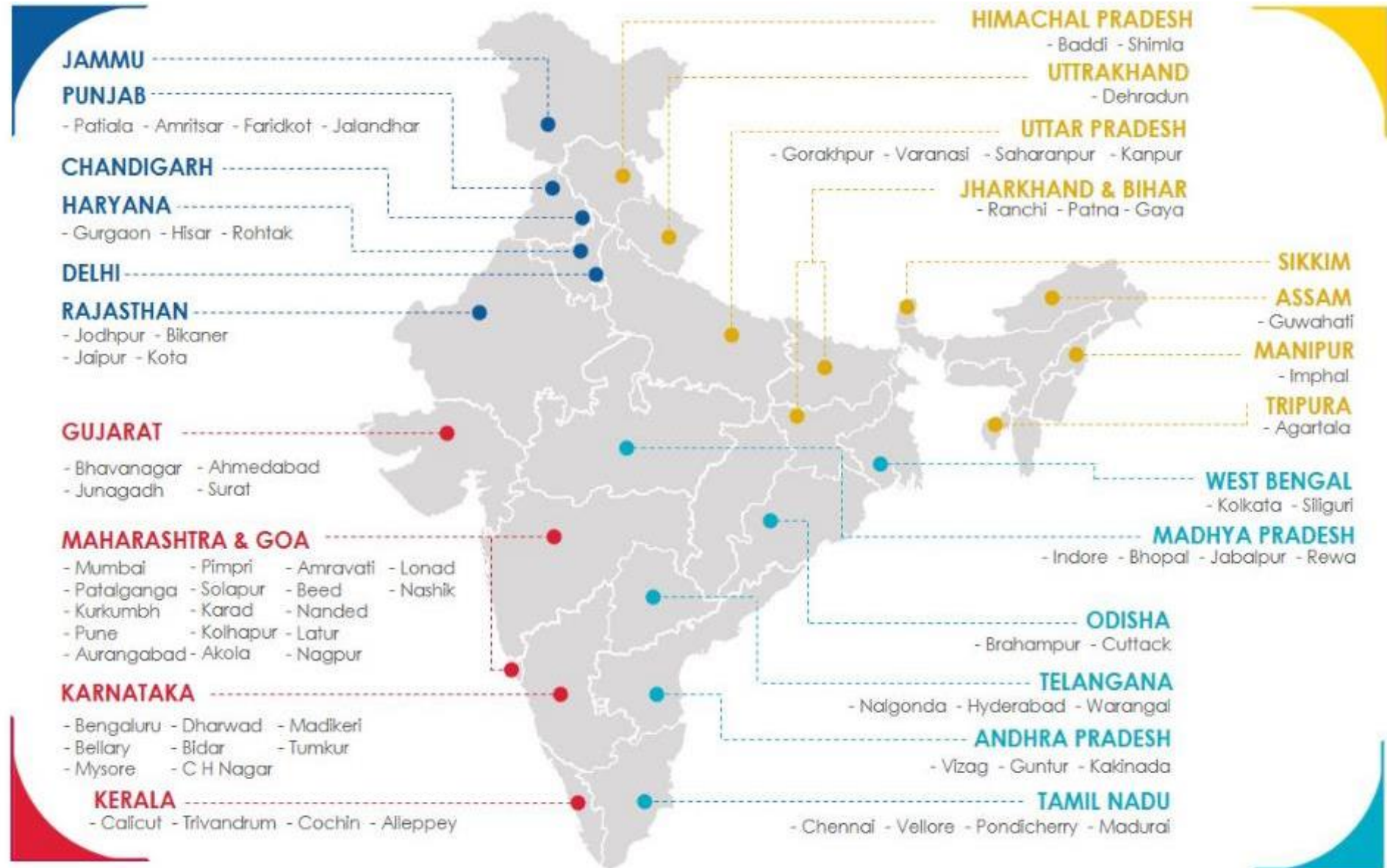

Cipla stands with Sikkim in fight against Covid-19

SE Report

GANGTOK, May 13: Cipla Limited today announced a number of initiatives that it has undertaken to tackle the Covid-19 pandemic in Sikkim. The company recently launched Rs. 25 crore ‘Caring for Life’ Covid-19-dedicated fund to further several immediate and long-term relief efforts the country needs to combat the crisis.

In Sikkim, an official communiqué informs, the company is working alongside the local administration to take the government’s Covid-19 management efforts further. Cipla’s initiatives are primarily targetting the safety and wellbeing of its employees, vendors, contract staff, the frontline administration and healthcare workers as well as lesser-

community who have low access to basic necessities, the release adds.

Cipla Sikkim has constituted a special Covid-19 taskforce to onboard the government prescribed norms for social distancing and infection control at Cipla units in Sikkim.

“In the interest of Cipla teams, the company is offering extended accommodation facilities where staff is required to stay in a mandatory quarantine of 15 days before they enter the manufacturing facility. Daily screenings are conducted for every individual entering the factory premises and any symptomatic cases are escorted back home and requested to self-quarantine. All employees are provided with sanitizers, masks, hand gloves and safety goggles to

The company is undertaking frequent sanitisation of the facility premises, employee transport vehicles and goods carriers. Pregnant women and susceptible employees have been advised to avail leave or work from home. Employees are also being given an alternate day off in a staggered manner to effectively implement social distancing at the workplace.”

Additionally, an extensive awareness campaign has been rolled out at the facility to destigmatise the disease and ensure that employees immediately report any symptoms or positive cases that they or their family members have come in contact with. In addition to the safety protocols, the company has also introduced other special measures. This includes the provision of free snacks to all

Emergency medical assistance services are being offered to employees and their families. Cipla has also facilitated a special Covid-19 medical insurance policy for the contractual workforce that covers self and family members (spouse and two children) with coverage of Rs. 25,000 per individual. The company is paying Rs. 300 per day of attendance as incentive to off roll workers as per the State government’s notification as well as incentivising employees as per company policy for working during the lockdown period, the release states.

Despite all challenges, Cipla Sikkim is ensuring business continuity so that manufacturing and distribution of essential medicines can continue for patients in these difficult times. Cipla has also

assist its patients in procuring essential medication across therapies from pharmacies and health-care institutions.

Cipla has been working closely with the local authorities to identify their most pressing needs to provide requisite support. Towards this, it has been supplying personal protective equipment (PPE), masks and sanitizers to various stakeholders like the government, healthcare workers and authorities at checkpoints.

In furtherance of its responsibility to the community, Cipla is providing essential supplies, such as medicines, sanitizers, masks and food to individuals in need. This includes the supply of medicines worth Rs. 20 lakh to the State Health department, the release
